Subject: Drafted CH 113 comments


Dear Alex,

I have received a copy of Cindy Turkle's response to "drafted CH 113", which she has submitted to your office. As the solid waste manager, for the Harrison County Landfill Commission (H.C.L.C.), I feel that I must **strongly support** all of the issues which Cindy Turkle has addressed.

The H.C.L.C.'s facility, in Harrison County, provides an environmentally safe disposal landfill, for our residents and businesses. We are proud of our facility and happy to work with the IDNR, in striving to provide *environmentally safe disposal of MSW*, for our population. The problem that our facility, and all landfills in Iowa have, is the IDNR putting the "cart before the horse", in a number of instances. Therefore, I am submitting a copy of Cindy Turkle's response, to you and our state representatives James Seymour & Matt Windschitl, as a sign of complete support in her statements and concerns.

Alex, I have always had a good working relationship with everyone at the IDNR, and feel that the IDNR is looking out for the best interests, of all Iowa residents.
